BY-LAWS
of the Kansas Polled Hereford Association

ARTICLE I
NAME

1. The name of this organization shall be the KANSAS POLLED HEREFORD ASSOCIATION (the "Association").

ARTICLE II
PURPOSE

1. The Purpose of the Kansas Polled Hereford Association shall be to promote in all ways the interests of the Hereford breed and its breeders, to increase the number of breeders and cattle in its territory, to assist in furnishing an outlet for breeding stock by public sale and otherwise to do any and all things in its power to advance the prosperity of the breed and its breeders.
2. The Kansas Polled Hereford Association shall be a not-for-profit organization.

ARTICLE III
DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

1. The business, property and affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Board of Directors (the "Board") consisting of nine members, to be elected from the membership, and by a majority vote of those members present and eligible to vote at the annual meeting.
2. The state shall be divided into districts as established by the Board of Directors. Every attempt shall be made by the nominating committee to select nominees to maintain representation from all districts and nominate one (1) member per open position.
3. Each director shall be elected for a term of three (3) years.
4. No person shall serve more than two consecutive terms or parts thereof, a part consisting of more than one-half of a full term on the Board. After one year has elapsed any former director shall be eligible to serve two more terms in succession.
5. The Board may fill vacancies in its membership and any director so appointed shall serve until the next annual meeting. At such annual meeting, a member shall be duly nominated and elected to fill the remaining unexpired term. Any director shall be removed from office automatically if he/she misses three consecutive board meetings. However, the Board may reappoint the removed director at its discretion.
 6. A. A nominating committee appointed by the President shall recommend a list of candidates for the Board of Directors.
 - B. The President shall also ask for additional nominations from the floor at the annual meeting.
7. Immediately after the annual meeting, the Board shall meet and elect, from their membership, a President and a Vice-President. The Board shall appoint a Secretary and a Treasurer. The Secretary-Treasurer may be one person if so desired by the Board.
8. All officers shall be elected or appointed for a period of one (1) year and when elected or appointed shall serve until the next annual meeting. The president shall serve only two (2) terms in succession. After one year has elapsed any former President shall be eligible to serve two (2) more years in succession.

ARTICLE IV
DUTIES

1. The Board of Directors shall manage the business, property and affairs of the Association.
2. The Board shall assume management of sales and shows held under the auspices of the Kansas Polled Hereford Association.
3. The President shall preside over all meetings of the Board and of the Association, supervise the work of other officers and committees, appoint special committees, serve as ex-officio member of all committees except the Nominating Committee, represent the Kansas Polled Hereford Association at related cattle functions and shall perform all duties usually pertaining to this office.
4. The Vice-President shall assist the President in conducting the affairs of the Association and shall assume the duties of the president in case of his/her absence.
5. The Secretary shall keep minutes of all meetings and compile them in permanent form. Shall attend to the correspondence of the Association. Shall keep the breed and farm journals informed of the activities of the Association.
6. The Treasurer shall keep an accurate and written record of receipts and disbursements. Shall deposit in the name of the Association all funds belonging to it in a financial institution acceptable to the Board. The Treasurer's books shall be open to inspection at any time by members of the Association. The Treasurer shall be bonded at the expense of the Association, unless specifically exempted by the Board. The Board or its authorized appointee for the purpose, shall annually audit the books and records of the Treasurer.

ARTICLE V
MEMBERSHIP

Any person, firm or corporation having joined this Association, shall thereby become subject to the rules and By-Laws then in force or later adopted by the Association.

1. Active membership: Any reliable person, firm or corporation in the State of Kansas who is actively engaged in the production of registered Hereford cattle or commercial Hereford influenced cattle is eligible to become an active member of the Association and be entitled to all the benefits and privileges of membership.

2. Associate membership: Associate members have all privileges except those of voting, serving as director, and/or holding an office.

A. Associate, Out-of-State. Any reliable person, firm or corporation whose cattle are located outside of the state of Kansas and who is actively engaged in the production of registered or commercial Herefords is eligible to become an associate member of this Association.

B. Associate, Retired. Any reliable person who is retired from the cattle business and has no financial interest in any form of cattle production is eligible to become an associate member of this Association.

3. Any member not paying the annual dues on or before the annual meeting shall forfeit his/her membership.

4. Voting. Only one vote may be cast by each active membership.

ARTICLE VI MEETINGS

1. The regular annual meeting of the membership shall be held each calendar year at a date, time, and place designated by the Board.

2. The Board shall meet immediately following the annual meeting and through out the calendar year as determined by the Board.

3. Special meetings of the Board may be called by the President.

4. The President shall call a special meeting of the Board of Directors upon written request of two (2) directors.

5. The President shall call a special meeting of the Board of Directors or the membership upon written request of 25% of the members in good standing.

6. It shall be the duty of the President or Secretary to give notice at least ten (10) days in advance to all those eligible to attend such meetings regular or called. This notice can be published, mailed, or transmitted electronically.

7. Rules of Procedure.

A. The procedure at any meeting of the Association or Board shall be in accordance with these By-Laws.

B. In cases when no By-Law regulations apply, the most recent edition of Robert's Rule of Order shall govern.

ARTICLE VII QUORUM

1. Three directors shall constitute a quorum at a Directors meeting.

2. The members present at a regular or called meeting of the membership shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE VIII DUES

1. The annual membership dues, both active and associate, and such other assessments as deemed necessary shall be established at least two (2) months before the end of the fiscal year by the Board of Directors at a Board meeting. These dues and fees will go into effect for the next fiscal year.

ARTICLE IX COMPENSATION

1. The Officers and Directors shall receive no compensation for their services, but shall be entitled to expenses necessarily incurred while in the discharge of their duties. The decision as to the payment of said expenses shall be at the discretion of the Board.

2. The Secretary-Treasurer may be, at the discretion of the Board, compensated of his/her services.

ARTICLE X FISCAL YEAR

1. The Fiscal Year of this Association shall begin September 1st of each year and end on August 31st of the following year.

ARTICLE XII AMENDMENTS

1. The By-Laws may be changed and/or amended by a majority vote of the members present at any Annual Membership Meeting, or at any Special Membership Meeting which has been called for the purpose. Amendments to the By-Laws must be presented to the membership by either publishing, mailing, or transmitting electronically at least 30 days prior to the Annual Meeting or to the Special Membership Meeting so call for that purpose.

DRAFT COPY of suggested revisions to the By-Laws of the Association. Reviewed on Aug. 26, 2003 by the Board of Directors and recommended to the Association for Review and adoption.

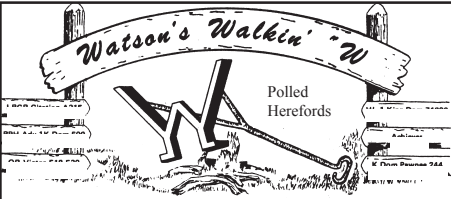
