## Plan to Attend the Junior Show — May 27-28

The joint polled and horned Kansas Junior Hereford Show will be held at the Abilene fairgrounds on Saturday, May 27, and Sunday, May 28. Two new changes that will be implemented at the 2006 show are: 1) An American Hereford Association (AHA) Steer Certificate will be required for both horned and polled steers; 2) Polled and horned bulls, bred-and-owned females, pair of heifers, cow-calf pairs and steers will be shown together.


